Develop an understanding of the history of Western cinema from the 20th and 21st centuries. Examine and understand the various roles in film production, learn about the techniques of telling stories on film, examine the conventions of specific genres of movies, reveal how to tell powerful stories using this medium and learn about the impact the film industry has had on the arts, politics, technology, and society (and vice versa). Students will build knowledge and understanding of films and theories of film, develop research and presentation skills, improve critical thinking and become fluent in the language of cinema.
