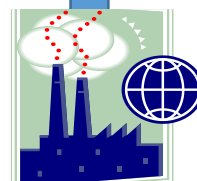

Grade 10

General Business

BBI 201 – Introduction to Business

This course introduces students to the different functions of business, including accounting, marketing, information and communication technology, human resources, and production.

Course topics include:

Entrepreneurship:

BDI 3C1 – Entrepreneurship: The Venture

Learn to recognize opportunities and establish a plan for an enterprising business. Do you have what it takes to be an entrepreneur?

Accounting:

BAF 3M1 – Financial Accounting Fundamentals

An ideal course for those thinking about pursuing business post-secondary or those who want to start their own business.

Course topics include:

- Understanding the accounting cycle
- Accounting for a service & merchandising business
- Internal Control, Financial Analysis, & Ethics

Grade 11

Business Leadership:

BOH 4M1 – Business Leadership: Management Fundamentals

Learn about the role of management in business.

Course topics include:

- Leading, Planning, and Controlling in business
- Ethics, Social Responsibility, Management Challenges

Accounting:

BAT 4M1 – Financial Accounting Principles

Explore accounting in greater depth. Strongly recommended for those pursuing business at the post-secondary level.

Course topics include:

- Merchandising, Inventory, & Internal Controls
- Short-Term & Long-Lived Assets
- Corporations & Partnerships
- Financing, Analysis, & Decision Making

Prerequisite: BAF 3M1 with recommended 70%

International Business:

BBB 4M1 – International Business Fundamentals

Learn about the opportunities and challenges of conducting business on an international scale.

Course topics include:

- International Business, Trade, & Competitiveness
- Politics, Economy, Culture & Trends
- Marketing, Supply Chain Management, Ethics

Finance:

IDC 4U1 – Building Financial Security

Learn about investments and the role they play in both personal and business applications.

Course topics include:

- Personal Finance
- The Economy & the Stock Market
- Portfolio Management & Estate Management

Computer Studies



Why Take Programming?

- ✓ Learn how to follow programming logic which trains your mind to think in more analytical ways
- ✓ Learn how to debug a program which teaches you problem solving skills

ICS 201 – Introduction to Computer Studies

This course introduces students to computer programming. Using Alice (a 3-D environment) and other programming languages, students will create simple programs and animations. This course also looks at all the different parts of a computer and how they work together and interact with the software. The last part of the course builds on concepts previously learned using a different language.

Prerequisite: None

ICS 3U1 – Introduction to Computer Science

This course introduces students to computer science and programming by giving students challenging problems to solve. Using Java, students will create programs that solve mathematical and business related problems. Take this course if you enjoys the challenge of problems solving

Prerequisite: None

ICS 4U1 – Computer Science

This course expands on what students learned in ICS 3U1, by looking at advanced topics in computer science like Project Management, Object-Oriented Programming, Searching and Sorting as well as Algorithm analysis. Take this course if you enjoyed ICS 3U1 and would like to experience working in a group to create a large software project.

Grade 12 – Canadian and International Law – CLN 4U1

(University)

Learn about legal issues and how they are addressed in Canadian and international law.

Course topics include:

- Principles of Canadian and international law
- Human Rights and Freedoms
- The Criminal Justice System
- Labour and Environmental Law

Prerequisite: Any university or university/college preparation course in Canadian and world studies, English, or social sciences and humanities
