
ENG4U STEM-Focus



What is STEM English?

No Shakespeare. No essays. This course is intended to prepare students for the language needs in pursuing a post-secondary education in science, technology, engineering, and math (STEM). The curriculum expectations of this course are identical to those in the ENG4U1 course, but they will be taught with the needs and interests of STEM students in mind. Important areas of focus in this course will be on developing tools and strategies to improve writing, fostering approaches to read and analyse texts – particularly nonfiction texts – effectively, and enhancing research skills to assist in developing and critiquing arguments.

Who should take STEM English?

STEM English is not open to all grade-12 students. It is specifically for students pursuing a STEM pathway after high school. To be eligible to submit this supplementary application form for the STEM English course, students must be enrolled in two (2) of the following courses: ICS4U, MCV4U, MDM4U, MHF4U, SBI4U, SCH4U, SPH4U, TEJ4M.
